Dear Mr. Curry:

Please find enclosed a Compliance Order from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. The Order states that, except as required by this Order, cease all earth disturbance activities on the above-referenced property until the Department provides you with written authorization to resume activities.

This Order also requires that you revise your Erosion and Sediment (E&S) Control Plan immediately addressing the deficiencies outlined in the Fayette County Conservation District's review of the current E&S plan. In addition, the E&S controls you install must be appropriate for special protection watersheds. Temporary and permanent stabilization measures should be employed in the disturbed areas.

The Department of Environmental Protection is the agency with the authority to administer and enforce the Clean Streams Law, the Act of June 22, 1937, P.L. 1987, as amended, 35 P.S. §691.1 *et seq.*, and Section 1917-A of the Administrative Code, the Act of April 9, 1929, P.L. 177 as amended, 71 P.S. §510-17, and the Rules and Regulations of the Environmental Quality Board adopted thereunder.

The undersigned authorized representative of the Department has conducted an inspection of the above project on the above date and has determined that violations listed in this Order exist. This Order constitutes a separate Order for each violation listed.

Pursuant to Sections 5, 316, 402, and 610 of the Clean Streams Law (35 P.S. §§691.5, 691.316, 691.402, and 691.610) and Section 1917-A of the Administrative Code, as amended, 71 P.S. §510-17, the Department hereby ORDERS that the person shall perform the remedial actions listed in this Order.

Failure to comply with this Order constitutes unlawful conduct under Section 611 of the Clean Streams Law (35 P.S. §691.611). Section 605 of the Clean Streams Law (35 P.S. §691.605) provides that the Department may assess a civil penalty of up to Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) per day for each violation of this Order.

Nothing contained in this Order shall be construed to relieve or limit the obligations of the above-mentioned person to comply with the terms and conditions of any permit existing or hereafter issued by the Department to this person, or to limit any civil or criminal liability of this person. Additional requirements may be imposed in the future by subsequent Department orders or other actions. Your prompt compliance with this Order will be considered when assessing a civil penalty for the violation(s) which is (are) the subject of this Order.

APPEAL NOTICE

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, P.O. Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, (717) 787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, (800) 654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure are also available in braille or an audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at (717) 787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.

Remedial Actions

- (X) Except as required by this Order, immediately cease all earth disturbance activities until written authorization is given by the Department to resume earth disturbance activities.
- (X) Implement the following best management practices at the project site so that the potential for accelerated erosion and sedimentation shall be minimized: (1) Temporary stabilization should be applied to areas where activity has ceased for 4 days or greater (2) Permanent stabilization should be applied to the disturbed areas
- (3) Erosion and sediment controls should be inspected weekly and after each runoff event until a uniform 70 % vegetative cover has been achieved.
- (4) Install erosion controls, considered ABACT for a Special Protection watershed in order to prevent sediment-laden water from leaving the site, with particular attention to the landing area

Complete implementation of these best management practices by July 1, 2014
